Heavy metals and RoHS

For the purpose of achieving high chemical and microbiological purity, only virgin fibres and food contact approved chemical additives are used as raw material in the production of paper and board at Stora Enso Consumer Board, Beihai Mill. The pulp and board manufacturing process conforms to established technology involving the use of generally recognized chemicals.

Paper and board produced at Stora Enso Consumer Board, Beihai Mill complies with the Packaging and Packaging Waste directive 94/62/EC as amended. According to analyses the total amounts of heavy metals have been the following:

Cadmium (Cd) < 0,5 mg/kg
Mercury (Hg) < 0,3 mg/kg
Lead (Pb) < 3,0 mg/kg
Chromium (Cr) < 2,0 mg/kg

The sum of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium in the paperboard is less than 100 ppm (EN 13428). The level of substances hazardous* to the environment in the paperboard is less than 0.1 %(EN 13428).

** Requirements for classification of substances or preparations dangerous to the environment and assigned the symbol "N" according to Directive 67/548/EC (Directive on Dangerous Substances) and its amendments or Directive 99/45/EC (Directive on Dangerous Preparations) and its amendments, and according to corresponding classification in the new Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures (CLP).*

Directive 2002/95/EC, the so called "RoHS directive", on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment is not applicable to our products. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) or polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) mentioned in the EU Directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS) are not used as a raw material or intentionally added* in the paper and board manufacturing process.

** Intentionally added shall mean deliberately utilized in the formulation of a material or component where its continued presence is desired in the final product to provide a specific characteristics, appearance or quality. Please note that this information is based on the information gained from our suppliers, and we do not routinely test our products against these substances.*

This information is valid for paper and board delivered by Stora Enso Consumer Board, Beihai Mill before further packaging converting.
